

tech cu arena





ABOUT THE RINK

Hockey is played on a frozen sheet of ice. On the ice, there are lines drawn to show where players can skate to and score from. In colder climates, you can play hockey outside on frozen ponds but in warmer places like California, hockey is played mostly on indoor ice rinks.

GAME TIME!

A full game lasts 60 minutes. There are three periods in a game that are each 20 minutes long. In between each period, there is an 18-minute intermission so that the ice can be cleaned and the players can take a break.

WHO IS ON THE ICE?

Hockey is played 6 vs 6. Players all have a special role on the ice. Each team plays:

3 Forwards


A forward's job is to score goals for their team.

2 Defenders

A defender's job is to stop forwards from scoring and protect their side of the ice.

1 Goalie

A goalie's job is to stop the puck from going in the goal.





YOU'RE IN TIME OUT!

When a penalty is committed during the game, the offending player has to spend time in the penalty box. How long they have to stay in the box depends on the penalty. Here are some common examples.

MINOR PENALTY 2 Minutes for:

- Tripping
- Hooking
- Slashing
- High Sticking

MAJOR PENALTY 5 Minutes for:

- Kneeing
- Boarding
- Hit to the head

HOCKEY EQUIPMENT


Hockey is a rough sport and players wear padding to keep themselves safe. Players and goalies wear different pads on the ice.





AROUND THE RINK

Keep an eye out for these common sights at Tech CU Arena.



ZAMBONI

Cleans the ice between periods. It uses water to scrape and smooth the ice to make it easier for the puck to slide on.

VIDEOBOARD


Hanging above center ice, the videoboard is the best place to see the score, replays, and other info during stoppage of play.

FRENZY

Frenzy is the mascot for the Barracuda. You'll see Frenzy running around and hyping up the crowd!



When the Cuda play on the road, they can cross into different time zones. That means game times for them are different than the time in San Jose.


